Using Gift Aid means that for every pound you give, as long as you are a UK Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax payer, we get an extra 25 pence from the Inland Revenue, helping your donation to go further.

This means that £10 can be turned into £12.50 just so long as donations are made through Gift Aid. Imagine what a difference that could make, and it doesn't cost you a thing. Your donation can be large or small and be one-off or a regular donation, including Friends.

Higher rate taxpayers can claim tax relief on their donation through their annual tax return.
